† Remember these upcoming Golf League Dates - League Meeting Night Thursday, April 14th 7:30 p.m. and the first night of golf April 28th.

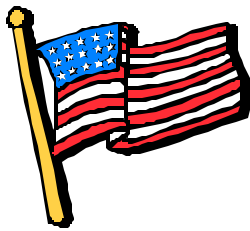
