Scrubbing Bubbles for a Shiny Car

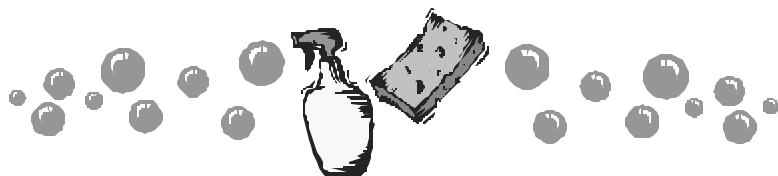
Come down to the lodge on
