It is a great honor to finally be able to say that I am the Jr. Elks President!!!

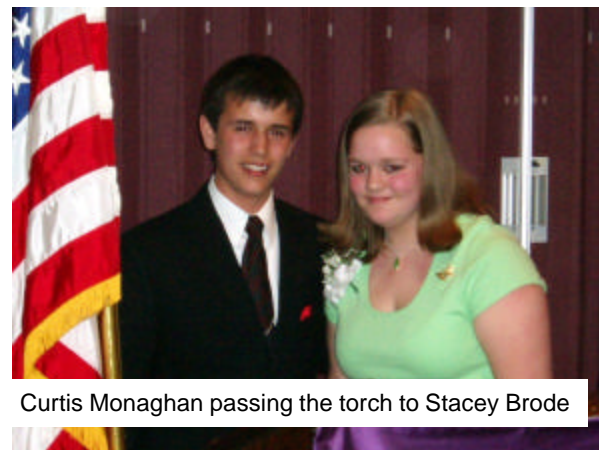
Our installation on April 9th was excellent, and we once again would like to thank every single person who showed up !!!
