

## News from the Jr. Elks

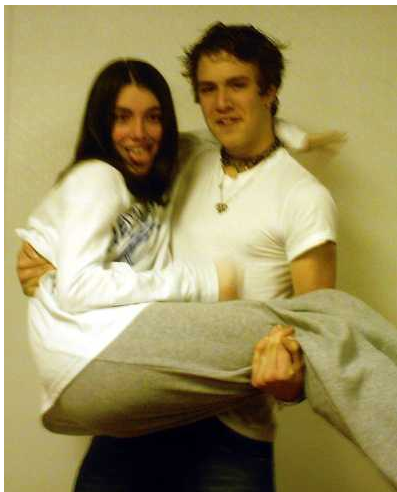
Dear Fellow Elks,
